

DRUG TEST TYPES EXPLAINED

URINE TEST

Common and non-invasive, urine tests can detect recent drug use commonly within the last few days.

BLOOD TEST

More precise and invasive, blood tests detect drug use within hours to a few days.

HAIR TEST

Offers a longer detection window, revealing drug use over past months by analyzing hair samples.

DETECTION WINDOW

Varies by test type: urine (days), blood (hours-days), hair (months).

ACCURACY LEVELS

Blood tests are highly accurate; urine tests are less precise; hair tests reveal long-term use.
