Observations (Without Interpretation) Note verbal and non-verbal behavior. Avoid assumptions or labeling. Example: 'Client appeared withdrawn, arms crossed, minimal eye contact.' Identified Risks or Clinical Concerns Escalation in conflict or emotional dysregulation Interference with client progress or safety Client disclosure of harm, discomfort, or boundary violations Clinical Rationale for Pause State clearly why continued family involvement may be clinically inappropriate at this time. Example: 'Based on observed regression in client progress and escalating emotional volatility during family sessions, a temporary pause is indicated.'
